Being the Church

I need to make a confession to all of you!

I like eating donuts! My favorites are glazed donuts with chocolate icing. Yummy!

Here is another confession. The chocolate donuts at Mary’s Donuts in Lakeside are really good. Whenever I get the craving for a chocolate glazed donut, that is where I head. Now I don’t know all of the people behind the counter but they know me enough that some of them ask, “Are you interested in getting your usual?” That is a little embarrassing but it is fun to be known!

Being acknowledged by others is something most of us like. It is an indication by another person that you are known. That is an important part of being a church. We need to be known by one another.

Going to church is a counter-cultural thing, especially for us in San Diego. There are so many different options to do on a Sunday like going to the beach, or taking a hike, or going out to breakfast with friends. So, when we come to church, it is nice when we are known, when we are greeted by one another with a friendly “hello” and a warm smile.

I think that one motivating factor for a person to attend church is the relationships that they have with others. When I know someone and they know me, I feel a connection. It is something that I look forward to and when someone is not there, I miss that connection. That is an important part of being a church, being a family of faith.

So this month, think of someone you can invite to church in the near future. Pray about it. Think of someone who might like coming to LCPC. Maybe they would like coming to a Sunday worship service or to one of our upcoming ministry events like Trunk or Treat or our Prayer Breakfast in November or maybe one of our holiday services like the Christmas Concert or Christmas Eve Service. Maybe there is someone that needs to come to church because of a situation in their life or because of a relationship that needs mending.

And when they come, give them a big “hello” and help them feel welcomed to this place we call church.

FROM YOUR SESSION:

- Session approved a \$5,000 donation (from our Missions Fund) to Samaritan's Purse for victims and those displaced by the Hurricane Helene that have affected so many in Florida, Georgia and the Carolina's.
- Session approved November 3rd as the date for our Annual Congregational Meeting, following Worship. We will be approving the Pastor's compensation for 2025, and reviewing the 2025 budget. We also be approving our slate of Deacons and Elders for service beginning next year.
- Session approved our annual "Trunk or Treat" (with a pumpkin hunt added to the fun, on October 26th). Volunteers are needed.

STEWARDSHIP UPDATE

As we begin the last 4 months of 2024, I feel a status update is in order. January to April of 2024 was awesome. LCPC was only \$519.38 in the red or negative (in 2023 we were \$13,038.15 in the red). The next 4 months (May-August) were disappointing: a small negative increase for May was followed by 3 more months of larger negative so at the end of August LCPC is \$23,559.90 in the red, which is still better than 2023, when LCPC was \$26,030.89 in the red. The summer months showed a significant drop in giving, which I assumed was caused by Summer Vacations.

As we enter the final 4 months of 2024, I hope we return to exceeding our pledges, as we did in January through April. A gentle reminder, that we have Building Fund envelopes in the pews. After all the work we have done to our campus we need to rebuild the funds for campus improvements. Thank you to all who are already making donations to the Building Fund. Please pray for our church's finances, and pray for the Children's Center, which has many openings due to students who graduated, and went to public school in August.

Praise God for His blessings and seek His wisdom and guidance, as we daily serve our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

LCPC AND OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD – SAMARITAN'S PURSE

“Let the children come to Me; do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God.”

Mark 10:14, ESV

Last year, together as one body provided 121 Christmas boxes along with providing 12 Gospel lessons for each child. Our boxes were delivered to the Philippines.

LCPC is committed to support Operation Christmas Child and ask for your support and prayers. Yes, we would like to meet a goal of creating 100 Operation Christmas Child boxes & raising \$1600 for shipping and providing 12 Gospel lessons, The Greatest Journey, for 100 children.

Please note: **We will collect items to put into the boxes, or you may provide a monetary gift and we will purchase items and pay for the shipping costs and Gospel lessons. Together we will fill the boxes on a Saturday in the Fellowship Hall. During the building of the boxes LCPC will provide refreshments and goodies to the volunteers. This is such a fun event and everyone is invited to participate.**

There is a collection box in the Narthex for you to drop off a toy, personal care item, accessories such as socks, sunglasses. Please identify if the item is for a Boy or Girl and one of three age categories.

Boy	2-4 years old	Girl	2-4 years old
Boy	5-9 years old	Girl	5-9 years old

Yes - Give a “WOW” item soccer ball (not inflated) with hand pump, stuffed animal, shoes, doll; Personal Care: toothbrush, washcloth, comb, hairbrush, small empty plastic bottle; School supplies: pens, pencils, sharpeners, crayons, markers, notebooks, coloring books, picture books, solar calculators;

Accessories: socks, sunglasses, jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries).

No - Do not give toothpaste, used or damaged items, scary or war-related items, no food, no candy, no lotions or liquids, no vitamins, no glass containers or aerosol cans.

In early November we will set up tables in the Fellowship Hall by gender and age categories and **together we will fill the boxes**. There will be something for everyone to be able to participate in and afterwards we will have goodies and refreshments for everyone.

Of course you are always welcomed to fill a box and return the filled box to the church, but we understand filling a box can be costly, not to mention our goal of raising funds for shipping and 12 classes. Therefore, consider giving a small item and placing it in the collection box. Your item will become part of our overall collection for the large packing day.

WAYS TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

There are a variety of ways that you can make a difference in the mission of our church. Your various contributions help us to live out that mission:

To Love God, Love People and Make Disciples of Jesus

Below are a variety of ways that you can help live this mission in our world:

Use your Gifts and Talents in Ministries at LCPC

As a family of faith, your gifts and talents are essential for LCPC to function. We are not the church without you. As each of us use our gifts, we are able to be God's Kingdom people here in Lakeside, East County and beyond. Your spiritual gifts will help us to be the church and to grow the church. Your talents and skills will help us to function as a church family. We need one another to be the Body of Christ.

Serve on a Committee or as an Elder or Deacon

Our church structure functions through the service of two elected offices: Elders and Deacons. These are the official ways that we function and run the church. Anyone may volunteer to serve on a committee (You don't have to be a member to serve on a committee but you do have to be an Elder to chair the committee). The standing committees at LCPC are: Spiritual Life (that oversees the worship and outreach), Discipleship and Missions (that oversees education and our mission outreach), Personnel and Preschool Board (that oversees the personnel of the church and serve as the Board of the Preschool), and Stewardship and Property (that oversees the finances of the church and the maintenance of the church buildings and grounds). The Deacons function as a separate body and serve the church by giving oversight to the various ministries of care by our church.

In-Kind Donations

There are a variety of specific, in-kind donations that can be used by the church for various ministry activities. Donations of these items (i.e. a case of bottled water, sleeves of paper cups for coffee, napkins, paper, disinfecting wipes) are helpful so that budgeted money can go toward other ministry causes. Call the church office for what is needed and a list of specific items. (*See below the items that are need). Tax donation receipts are available if you desire.

Community Service

Serving our community is another way that we make a difference for God's Kingdom here in Lakeside. There are a variety of opportunities, some on a regular basis (i.e. Lakeside HELPS Center) and others on

a one-time basis. The church office has a list of activities where we serve. (*See the opportunities to serve in our community on the attached list below)

SCRIP Gift Cards

LCPC offers Scrip gift cards to over 100 retailers like restaurants (Panera Bread, Starbucks, Olive Garden and many more), fast-food eateries, grocery stores (Sprouts, Albertsons, Vons), gas stations, Office Depot, Home Depot, Amazon, Michaels, Nordstrom, and many, many more. Rebates to the church range from 3–12% depending on the retailer and are used to fund ministries here at LCPC. Contact the church office for details of participating retailers and how you can purchase Scrip gift cards.

Recyclable Bottles and Cans

We collect recyclable bottles and cans for cash and use these funds for LCPC ministries.

Retirement Plan Contributions

If you are 70 ½ or older, you can make Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD) as a gift without incurring taxes.*

Stocks, Bonds and Mutual Funds

If you directly transfer your appreciated stock to LCPC instead of selling these first, you will not pay any capital gains tax and you may be entitled to a tax deduction.*

Endowment Funds

Create a memorial or legacy gift that will provide a source of support to our church in perpetuity.*

*Consult with your tax advisor to determine your estimated personal tax benefits and/or our church's treasurer.
